



Ele-fantastic Junk Modelling!

To make your very own elephant you will need:

- 1 (or more) empty and clean milk jug containers
- Scissors
- Brightly coloured materials to decorate like glitter/sequins or coloured tissue paper cut into squares
- PVA/white glue and brushes
- white card
- black pen

To make your elephant:

Stand the milk jug up and cut into it just below the handle. This will form the elephant's trunk. Then cut off the entire bottom half of the container and cut four legs into it. Ask a grown-up for help if you find this tricky!



Next, cover your milk jug in PVA glue and stick on your chosen decoration. That could be tissue paper squares, glitter, sequins or stickers - whatever you can find at home.



Let your elephant dry and she's all ready for the finishing touches including eyes and ears, which can be made from card and cut to size. Or you can stick on 'googly eyes' if you have them.



Ta-da! Your very own elephant is all ready for Worcester's Big Parade!
